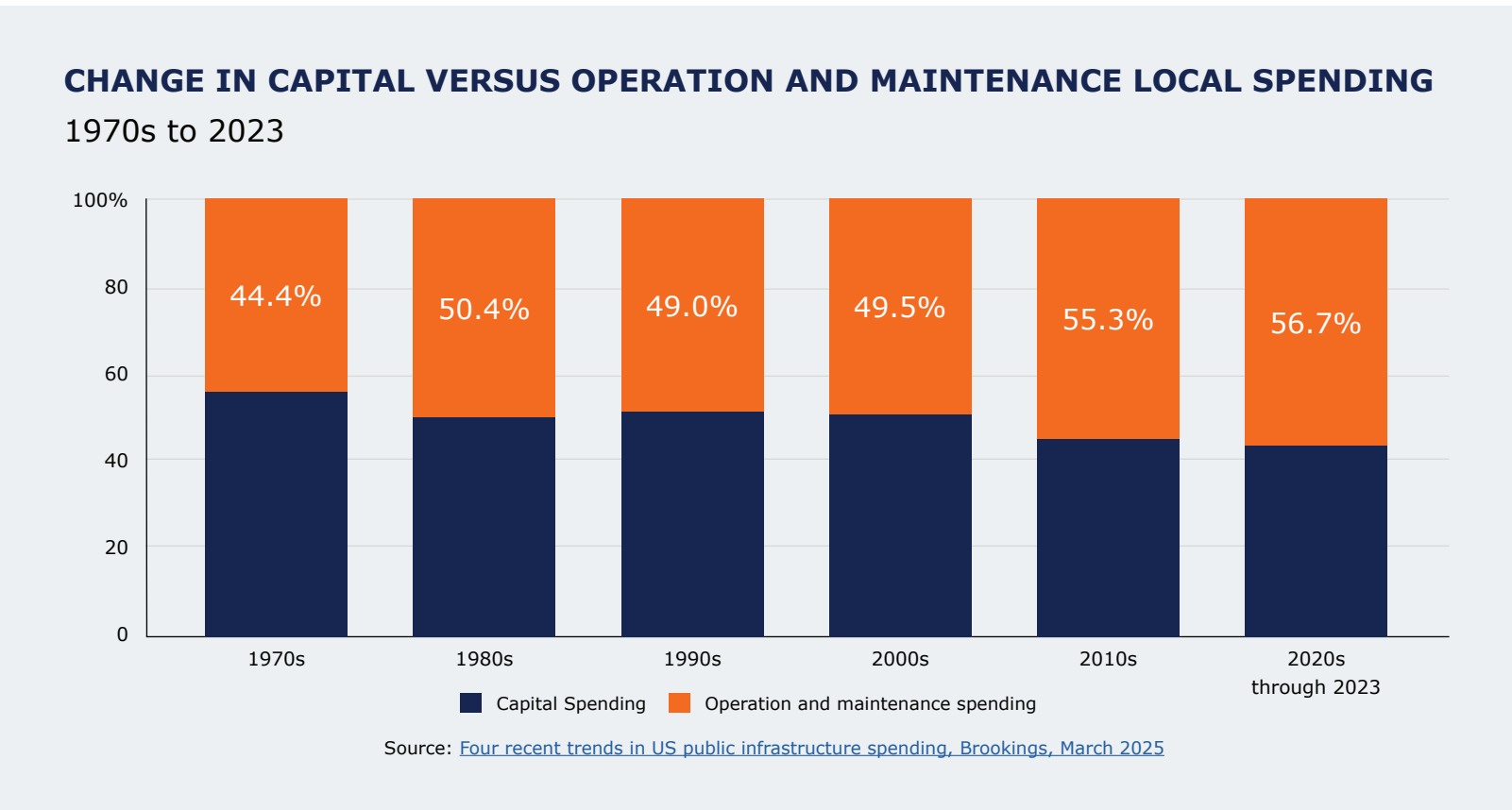
THOUGHT LEADERSHIP: INFRASTRUCTURE COMPANIES NEED LOCAL PARTNERS WITH NATIONAL SCALE
